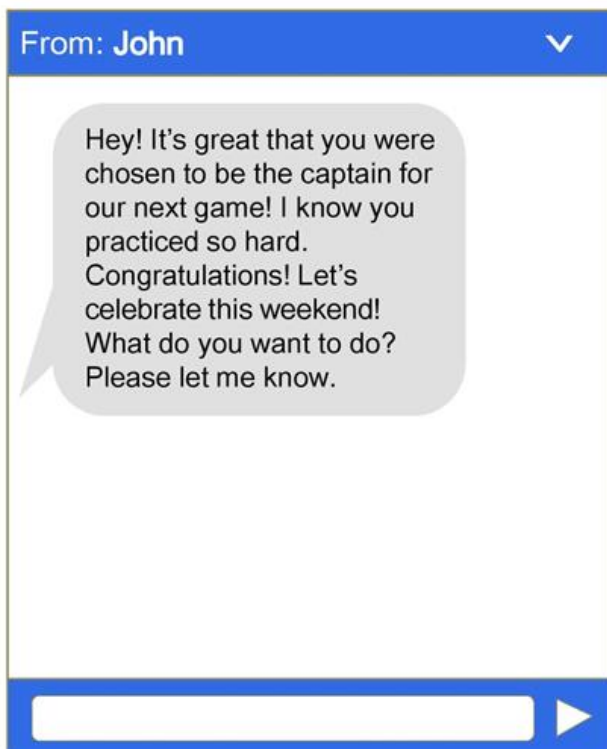

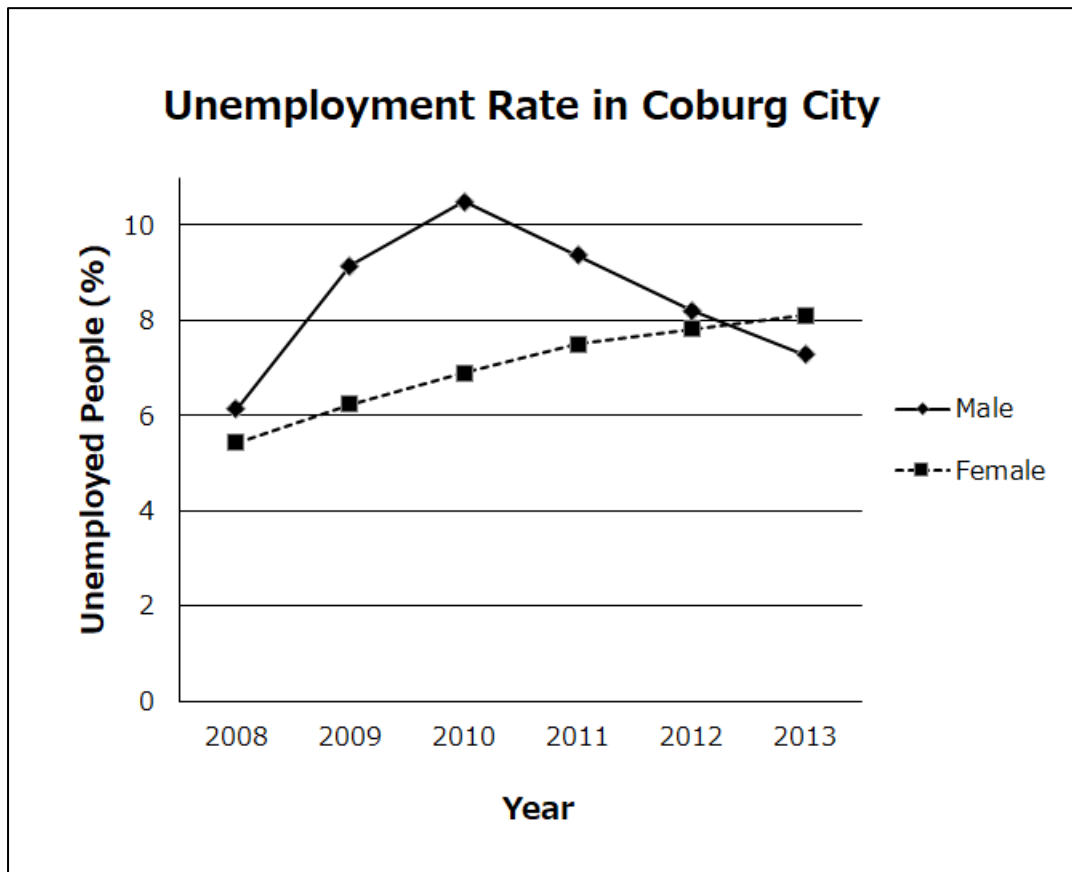

Solar Power Brings a Bright Future

Over the past few decades, sunlight, or solar energy, has been gaining attention as a new energy source. While the most common method of generating electricity is burning fossil fuels such as coal and oil, sunlight can also be converted to electricity through the use of solar panels. The popularity of solar panels has increased because many people believe that they are an effective way to generate power.

One of the obvious advantages of solar energy is that it is freely available everywhere. Since energy from the sun is unlimited, we do not have to be concerned about its availability. On the other hand, our primary energy sources today, fossil fuels, take millions of years to form, so they cannot be replaced easily once they are consumed. Therefore, it is not sustainable to rely on them because they are in limited supply. For countries like Japan, which has very few fossil fuel resources, solar power has great potential as an alternative energy source.

In addition, solar power is environmentally friendly. It allows us to produce electricity without causing too much pollution. On the other hand, burning oil and coal produces carbon dioxide, which is the main cause of global warming. Countries with limited fossil fuels need to import huge quantities of oil to help generate power. Oil is transported across the oceans using large container ships. Shipping accidents have resulted in oil spills polluting the oceans and damaging the surrounding coastlines. By choosing solar energy as an alternative to oil, we can help save our planet from these environmentally harmful practices.
